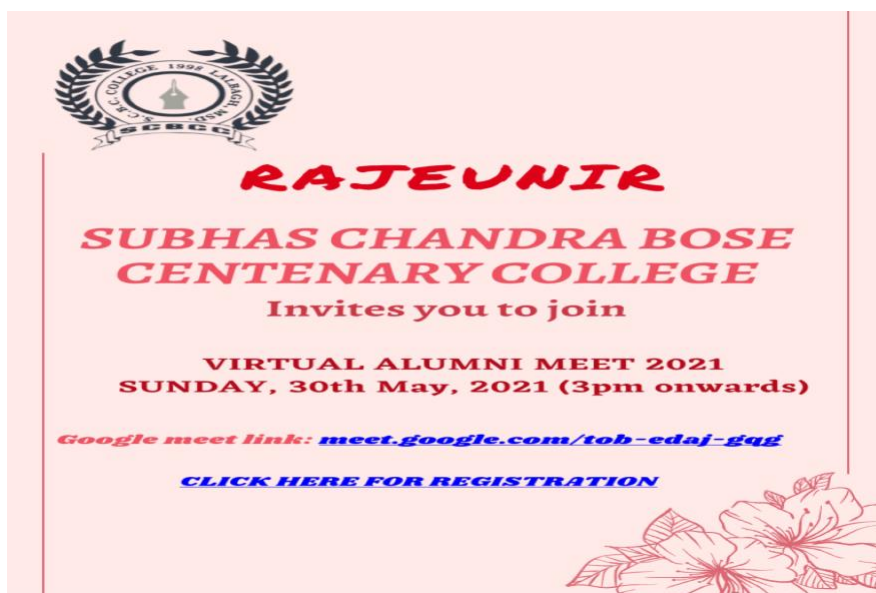
# Virtual Alumni Meet 2021

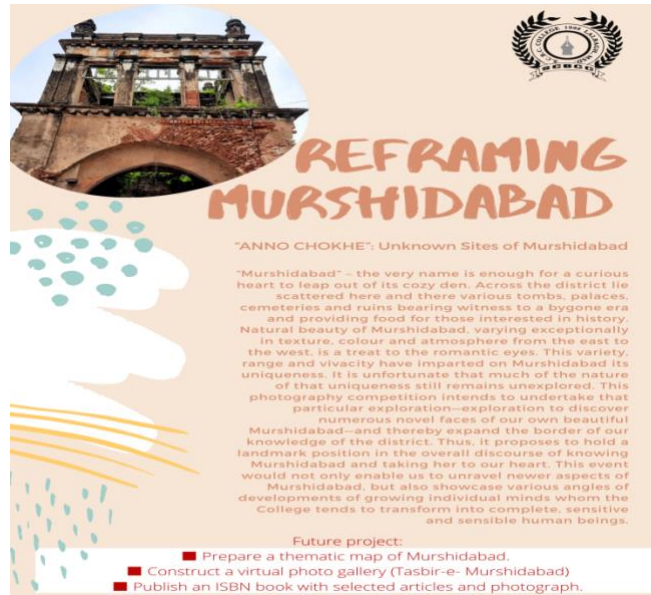

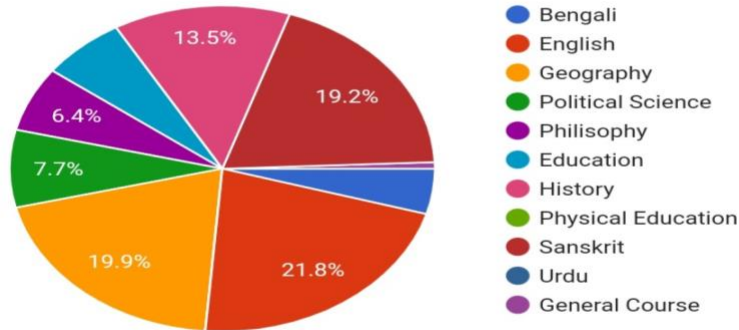

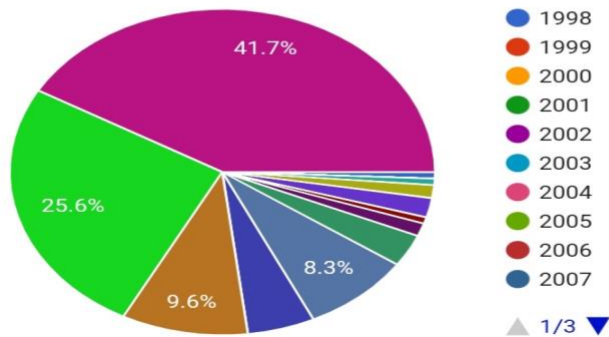

**INSTRUCTIONS**

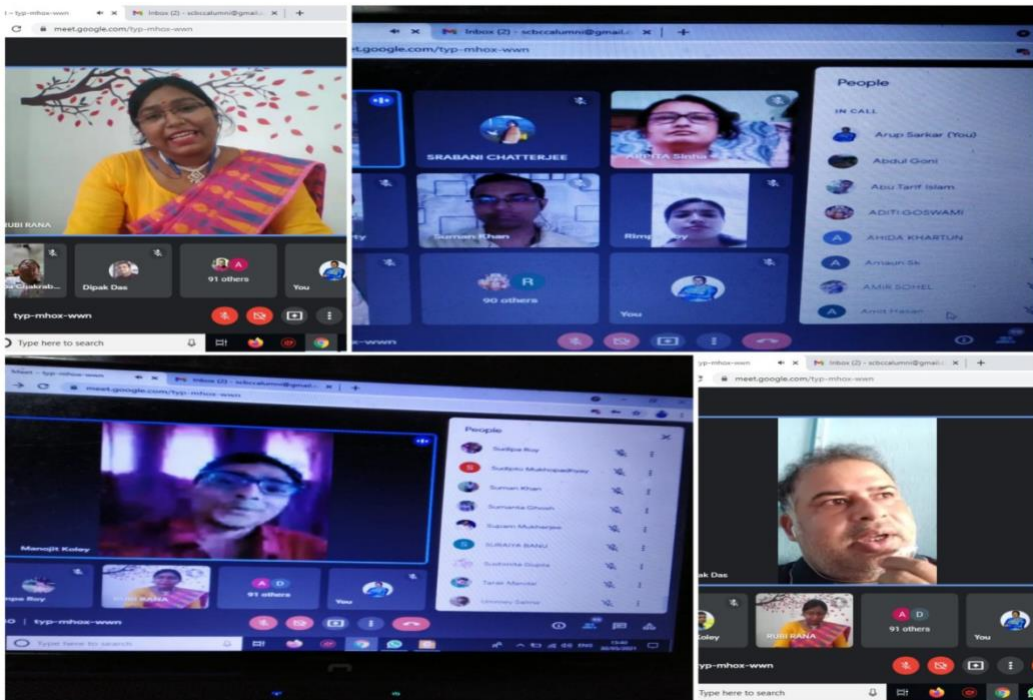
- A participant can submit only one photograph for the event.

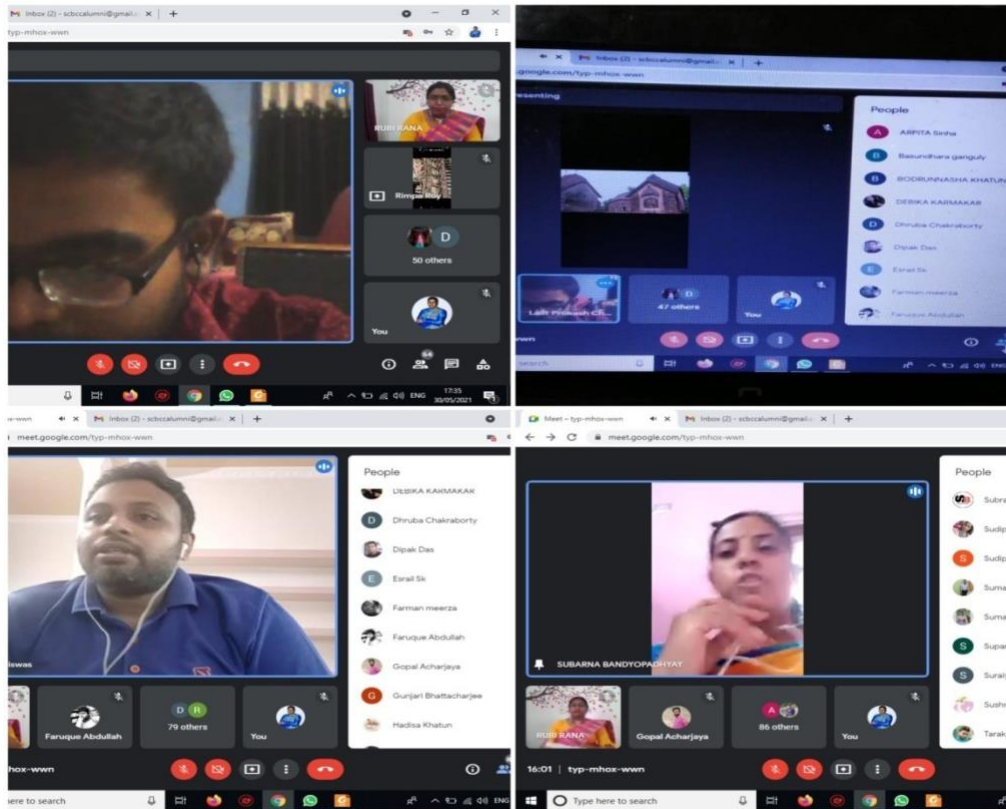
**N.B**
